By-Laws Issues:

- Must be a Full Senator for a full year before running for Officer Position
- Lose your seat if you transfer to a different department
- Alternates cannot Chair a Committee
- Alternates cannot run for Officer Position (unclear)

Research 2015-2016: peer universities have rolling elections, multiple elections per year, and membership (non-voting, join as member, participate)

By-Laws and Procedures Manual Approval Process:

- Proposed by Governance/Elections Committee to Executive Board
- Vote by Executive Board
- Vote by Senate
- By-Laws must be approved by Chancellor
