- It has been brought to our Committee's attention that there is a lapse in resources and training for digital access and literacy across the University. Our committee is working to create a response to this issue and will be working with other Senators as well as other committees.

Feed the Pack Food Pantry, Brian Mathis

- Feed the Pack, the food pantry at NC State, is looking for staff and faculty members to join on a volunteer base. The pantry is in great need of dedicated volunteers to keep doors open, especially over the summer months. Volunteers will sign up for 2 hours shifts on Monday-Friday. Some responsibilities include opening/closing the pantry, helping patrons, checking food in and out, organizing/shelving donations, and maintaining the pantry space.
- If you are interested, we will be having a group training on Thursday, May 2, from 11AM Noon. It will take place in the food pantry (Quad Commons- 2111 Dunn Avenue).
- It was suggested that employees ask their supervisors to use community service time or the use of a laptop to continue working while volunteering. It was also brought to the Senate's attention that the program is now accepting donations online.
