<u>Presenter:</u> Dr. Rupert W. Nacoste, Ph.D is an Alumni Distinguished Undergraduate Professor of Psychology at North Carolina State University and the author of Taking on Diversity: How We Can Move from Anxiety to Respect.



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Dr. Nacoste presentation was on "Jokes and Pokes about other Folks". He stated to help North Carolina State University develop strategies for managing diversity, he has created an undergraduate course to help students understand diversity dynamics in their everyday social interactions, "Interpersonal Relationships and Race." Based on student writings from that course, in September, 2012, he self-published his book "Howl of the Wolf".
